Sealed tenders are invited by Centre for development of Imaging Technology (C-DIT) for the **Development Mobile Application for Trial Monitoring** as per the detailed scope of work given in the "**Part-A**" of the Tender Document. The terms and conditions are as under.

The sealed tenders are to be submitted in prescribed format on your business letter head duly stamped and signed with date on each page for unconditional acceptance to the terms prescribed by CDIT. The details/supporting documents wherever applicable, should be duly authenticated by the vendor/s. No overwriting is admissible

1. The sealed tender document contained in Envelope duly super scribed as "**Development Mobile Application for Trial Monitoring**" should **be addressed (by name) to The Registrar** and sent on the address given below by registered post/speed post. The envelope can also be delivered directly to the Office of the Registrar, CDIT at Thiruvallom so as to reach the office by the stipulated date and time.

3. CDIT shall not be liable for any postal delays what so ever and Tender received after the stipulated time/date are liable to be rejected straightway.
4. Non adherence to any of the terms & conditions, as stated in tender document shall render the bid invalid.
5. Incomplete Tender shall be rejected out rightl. No alterations, amendments or modifications shall be made by the Bidder in the Tender Document if any such alterations are made or any special conditions attached, the bid is liable to be rejected without making reference to the Bidder.
6. The bid shall be opened at CDIT Head Office at Thiruvallom in the presence of those tenderer(s) or authorized representative who wish to be present and No separate communication will be sent in this regard. In the event of due date being

a closed day or declared Holiday of State Govt the due date for opening of the bids will be the following working day at the appointed date, time & venue.

7. The CDIT shall assess the Competence and Capabilities of the Tenderers on the basis of credentials given in the Bid and shall have right to reject the candidature of any of the Tenderer without assigning any reasons.
8. Prices quoted in the bid shall expressly be inclusive of all statutory taxes, fees, cesses, duties, levies, charges, surcharges and any other statutory and non-statutory components etc. No component of cost / tax shall be paid by the CDIT unless the same is included specifically in the Tender.
9. Penalty for the late delivery and late implementation, than the stipulated date and time would be levied at the rate of half percent per week to be calculated on work order subject to a maximum of 10 percent of the value of work order. In case of delay beyond fifteen days from the stipulated period, CDIT may, at its discretion, cancel the order and arrange to procure the same from the next bidder on the panel/open market at the sole risk, cost and responsibility of the vendor.
10. The Tender shall be valid for 120 days only from the date of their opening.

Documents Establishing Applicant's Eligibility

The following documents are required to be submitted along with the Tender. Non-submission of the documents or submission of incomplete, misleading or false information may render the tenderer liable for out rightly rejection or cancellation of its tender.

1. A copy of Work Orders of development of more than three Mobile App in for Government/ Depts during the past two years (Documentary proof to be attached)
2. The bidder should be produce detail of PAN Number (Documentary proof to be attached).
3. The company should not have been barred / blacklisted / disqualified by any Regulators / Statutory Body / Government Body in India.
4. The company must not have been declared bankrupt / insolvent or should not have filed for bankruptcy / insolvency in the past five years or in the process of being declared bankrupt / insolvent before any designated authority in any country.

Scope of the Project

The scope of the project covers the following.

- Mobile Application for Trial Monitoring
- Web Interface to add case details by Court PC
- Admin module to manage the application

The following section gives in detail various features of the application.

1. Mobile Application for Trial Monitoring

The proposed mobile application will let the court PC to update trial proceedings and helps police official to get notified about cases in which they are linked. The features required are listed below:

- User Registration
- Dashboards
- Update Hearing Details (Court PC Login)
- Case Details (Officer Login)
- Notification

2. Web Interface to add case details by Court PC

Court PC will be able to add case details into the application through the web interface with the same login credentials. The case details added to the system can be either "New" or "Appeal". If the case adding is an "Appeal", user need to input who initiated it.

Court PC need to input FIR number, case number, Police station and Court Type into the system as primary fields. Details of Case Witness and Accused that needed be entered in the system includes, Name, Address (Optional). While entering the details of Investigative officers, Court PC can enter, Name, PEN number, Start Date and End Date as Investigative Officer.

3. Admin module for mobile applications and Website

The features included in the admin module are described in detail below:
